

Past-President

The Past President serves as advisor to the President and the Board to ensure continuity of leadership. The Past-President helps to ensure all Board positions are filled and incumbents trained in their roles. The Past-President is the key role for ensuring programming topics and content are identified for chapter events, relevant to the needs and interests of the chapter members. This position also oversees the annual Board elections process, ensuring that continuing Board members are confirmed in January and interested Board members are nominated in February and elections finish in March, so that the new Board of Directors can be announced in April and involved in the Spring/Full-day Conference planning and execution. This Board position is the **third of a three-year** commitment that began as President-Elect, followed by President. The estimated time commitment for this role is 5-10 hours per month. **Candidates must be from a national CUPA member institution.**
